**Swimming:** In year 6 currently we have 17% of children able to swim 25m competently in a range of strokes. This figure will be re-evaluated in the summer term when a catch up program is run for those children who have not yet met the standard. Through the swimming curriculum the children also learn lifesaving skills such as treading water and self-rescue.
